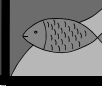

#### **NEW TESTAMENT READING: Ephesians 4:1-16 (Pew Bible 801)**

As a prisoner for the Lord, then, I urge you to live a life worthy of the calling you have received. <sup>2</sup> Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love. <sup>3</sup> Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace. <sup>4</sup> There is one Body and one Spirit— just as you were called to one Hope when you were called— <sup>5</sup> one Lord, one Faith, one Baptism; <sup>6</sup> one God and Father of all, Who is over all and through all and in all.

<sup>7</sup> But to each one of us grace has been given as Christ apportioned it. <sup>8</sup> This is why it says:

“When He ascended on high,  
He led captives in His train

and gave gifts to men."

<sup>9</sup> (What does "He ascended" mean except that He also descended to the lower, earthly regions? <sup>10</sup> He who descended is the very one who ascended higher than all the heavens, in order to fill the whole universe.) <sup>11</sup> It was He who gave some to be apostles, some to be prophets, some to be evangelists, and some to be pastors and teachers, <sup>12</sup> to prepare God's people for works of service, so that the Body of Christ may be built up <sup>13</sup> until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ.

<sup>14</sup> Then we will no longer be infants, tossed back and forth by the waves, and blown here and there by every wind of teaching and by the cunning and craftiness of men in their deceitful scheming. <sup>15</sup> Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will in all things grow up into Him who is the Head, that is, Christ. <sup>16</sup> From Him the whole Body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work.

**HOLY GOSPEL Luke 10:25-37 (Pew Bible 711)**

<sup>25</sup> On one occasion an expert in the law stood up to test Jesus. "Teacher," he asked, "what must I do to inherit eternal life?"

<sup>26</sup> "What is written in the Law?" he replied. "How do you read it?"

<sup>27</sup> He answered: "'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength and with all your mind'; and, 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'"

<sup>28</sup> "You have answered correctly," Jesus replied. "Do this and you will live."

<sup>29</sup> But he wanted to justify himself, so he asked Jesus, "And who is my neighbor?"

<sup>30</sup> In reply Jesus said: "A man was going down from Jerusalem to Jericho, when he fell into the hands of robbers. They stripped him of his clothes, beat him and went away, leaving him half dead. <sup>31</sup> A priest happened to be going down the same road, and when he saw the man, he passed by on the other side. <sup>32</sup> So too, a Levite, when he came to the place and saw him, passed by on the other side. <sup>33</sup> But a Samaritan, as he traveled, came where the man was; and when he saw him, he took pity on him. <sup>34</sup> He went to him and bandaged his wounds, pouring on oil and wine. Then he put the man on his own donkey, took him to an inn and took care of him. <sup>35</sup> The next day he took out two silver coins and gave them to the innkeeper. 'Look after him,' he said, 'and when I return, I will reimburse you for any extra expense you may have.'

<sup>36</sup> "Which of these three do you think was a neighbor to the man who fell into the hands of robbers?"

<sup>37</sup> The expert in the law replied, "The one who had mercy on him."

Jesus told him, "Go and do likewise."

Prince of Peace has been sponsoring their mission for three years – NOW we get to meet them in person – **a real privilege.**

David was born and raised in Africa. His parents were long time missionaries. David and Valerie met when they both attended Concordia University in Mequon, WI.

David felt the call to be a missionary and after much study they were assigned to the country of Ghana, West Africa in 2003. David’s responsibility has been in the area of Literacy and Scripture use. His most recent project has revolved around developing the Komba primers. These primers make it possible for the Konkomba people to learn to read and write in their own language.

David, Valerie and family are now on furlough for a year and a half and are living in Flower Mound, TX while David completes his Masters degree at the Institute of Linguistics.

While on furlough they enjoy visiting their sponsoring congregations and meet the people who support and pray for them. They have three children, Michaela (4) born in the U.S., Josiah (2 ½) and Micah (1) both born in Africa.

We praise God for Christians such as this family who are willing to leave their home and country to bring the Good News of salvation to people in Africa.
